## Getting to/from Poznan Airport/Hotel Mercure Poznan Centrum

Poznan Airport is situated in 285 Bukowska Street (national road 307), about 7 kilometers west of the city center. Hotel Mercure Poznan Centrum is situated in 20 Roosevelta Street.



## PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Poznan Airport is well-connected with the city center by public transport. There are bus stops right in front of the passenger terminal and in its close vicinity. The main bus connection between Poznan Airport and Hotel Mercure Poznan Centrum is provided by line 59. It takes around 20 - 25 minutes (13 bus stops) to get from the airport to the Hotel Mercure Poznan Centrum.



Public transport tickets are available at the newspaper stands both in the arrival hall (in T3 terminal) and in the departure hall (in T2 terminal), as well as in the ticket booth located at the bus stop in front of the departure hall. In some units of line 59, ticket vending machines are available. Stickers at the bus entrance inform about the possibility of an on-board ticket purchase. There is also a possibility of purchasing a ticket through a mobile phone CallPay system, moBILET, mPay or SkyCash. Public transport tariff in Poznan includes three types of paper ticket: time - limit ticket, single - journey ticket, short - term ticket.

A time-limit ticket entitles to an unlimited number of journeys in a period not longer than 10 or 40 minutes since it was validated, with as many changes of lines as necessary. The time - limit ticket entitles users to travel on all lines in Poznan, i.e. by bus or tram. This is a bearer ticket. During the first journey the ticket should be validated immediately after boarding the vehicle. After validation, the time - limit ticket remains valid throughout the number of minutes indicated by its nominal value. Real time of the journey is measured.

Public trannsport tariff in Poznan offers the following types of time - limit tickets:

- 10-minute which costs 3 zl.
- 40-minute which costs 4.6 zl.

It is recommended to buy 40-minute time – limit ticket.





## TAXI TRANSPORT

Right in front of T3 terminal (arrival hall) you may find a 24/7 taxi stand. It takes around 15–20 minutes to get from the airport to the Hotel Mercure Poznan Centrum by taxi, but it depends on traffic in the city.

Estimated transport cost is 30–40 zl.



Poznan Airport offers an application for passengers. You could go to Google Play and download Poznań Airport Guide. This is the official application which includs e.g: airport and parking plan, public transport timetable.
